



ACM E-VISA APPLICATION TIPS

GATHER THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION

You'll need photos or scans of the following:

1. Yellow Fever Immunization Card
2. Passport
3. Passport-Size Photo
4. Return Ticket/Itinerary

FILE UPLOAD TIPS

For eVisa document uploads, images must be low resolution—specifically under 250 KB in file size. An easy way to achieve this is by taking a screenshot of the photo and/or emailing the document to yourself from a cell phone, as it allows you to choose the image quality when sending. Select a lower quality option to ensure the file size meets the requirement.

Visa or Permit Type: Visa

Category: Uganda Ordinary/Tourist Visa

Subcategory: Single Entry

*If both your first and middle name are on your passport, list them both as your given name.

Examples: The passport says “John David Doe” - **Given Names:** John David **Surname:** Doe

The passport says “John D Doe” - **Given Name:** John D **Surname:** Doe

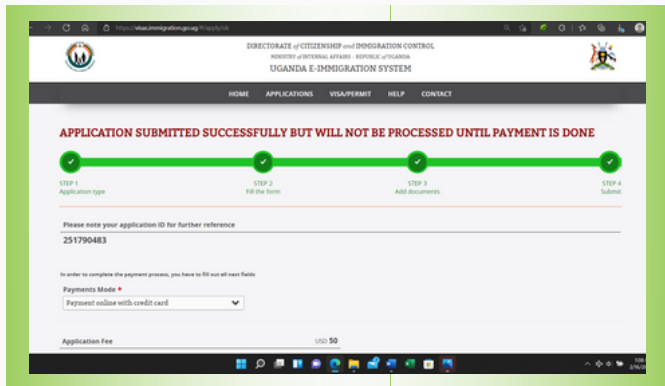
Address in Uganda: Plot 37 Acacia Avenue Kololo, Uganda

Purpose of Visit: Tourism

Port of Entry: Entebbe

DOUBLE CHECK THE ACCURACY OF ALL INFORMATION BEING ENTERED ON THE FORM UPLOAD DOCUMENTATION & SUBMIT

If the form is successfully submitted, you will see the following message:



PRINT FOR YOUR RECORDS

Print the page confirming you have successfully uploaded the application.

Document your Application ID.

PAY AND FINALIZE YOUR APPLICATION

Click the red PAY button. The application cannot be processed until payment has been made. The cost is \$51.50. All major credit cards & Paypal are acceptable forms of payment

Within a couple of hours you should receive a verification email letting you know your application was successfully submitted.

You will receive another email within 24 hours of payment - save this email!

You will be notified once your E-Visa has been approved.

PRINT YOUR E-VISA DOCUMENT *It's best to not rely on a digital copy of any document.

Once you receive your E-Visa document, print and take this with you to Uganda.

Your OFFICIAL Visa will be received upon arrival at the airport in Uganda.
